Frequently Asked Questions

When is Summer Camp held?

Multicultural Mondays Summer Camp and is held Mondays from June 18th to August 13th from 9am to 3pm.

Who are the Multicultural Monday Camp instructors?

The camp will be led by MVMC staff (Quincy Masur and Haley Austin). Additional assistance may be offered by community volunteers. All volunteers will pass a thorough background check.

What is the child to instructor ratio?

We maintain a child/teacher ratio of no greater than 6:1. There will be no more than 20 children in each camp.

Can I sign my child up for more than one camp?

YES! Each session will feature different activities so that your child can enjoy them all without repeating specific projects. Some camp elements do repeat, such as going to the park for water play, and the half hour of library time each morning.

Where will activities take place?

Activities will take place at the MVMC, Swanny Park, Grand County Public Library, and HMK. We may visit other locations for special field trips.

What about lunch?

The MVMC will provide lunch. We will attend HMK's free lunch program or provide a nutritious meal. If you wish that your child does not eat the lunch provided, please inform the MVMC and send an alternative lunch with your child.

*****IMPORTANT*****

What does my child need for camp?

CLOTHING: Please send your child to camp in comfortable clothes and shoes that can get wet and dirty from outside play. Please put your child's name on all of their clothing and contain it in an easy to carry durable backpack or bag.

FOOD: Your child should always bring a water bottle with their name on it and two snacks: one for the morning and one for the afternoon. Lunch will be provided. If your child has any food allergies, please make sure to note that on the registration form. We do not allow children to share their lunch food.

If there are any field trips that will require additional items beyond the ones listed above, the MVMC staff will inform parents a week prior to the activity.

DO NOT BRING: Electronic games, personal toys etc. Cell phones are not allowed to be used at camp. Your child will be asked to turn their cell phone off and put it away until pick-up time. If you need to contact your child, please call the MVMC office at 435-259-5444. If there is an emergency, you can reach Rhiana Medina, MVMC Executive Director, on her cell phone at 801-860-1862. Cell phones are very disruptive; please support us by affirming our policy with your child.

Can someone else other than the listed authorized individuals pick up my child?

If your child will be regularly picked up by someone other than yourself or another parent/guardian please list them on the registration in the section titled "Additional Individuals Authorized to Pick-up My Child." If the child is going to be picked up by someone other than those you have listed on the registration form, let us know as soon as possible. You may send the child to camp with a written note of permission, or if it is last minute, call Quincy at 317-752-1665. If you plan to have your child

walk and/or bicycle to summer camp daily, please provide written permission so they can sign themselves out and thus are properly accounted for at the end of the day.

Can my camper walk or bike to camp?

If you plan to have your camper walk or bike to/from the MVMC, please let us know they have your permission. If we do not have a written note or the staff has not been communicated with, your child will not be allowed to walk/bike home alone.

What is your payment and cancellation policy?

Payment must be received prior to the start of camp. Payment is refundable as long as the MVMC is notified at least one week prior to the camp date.

What are your behavioral expectations?

In order to foster a fun and safe learning environment, MVMC asks that all Summer Camp participants follow the CARES models of behavior expectations. Outlined below is the CARES model for your review. Please go over this with your child before the start of summer camp. We will go over the CARES model each week and briefly each morning as a reminder for the campers.

C: Cooperation

- Follow directions.
- Work as a team.

A: Attitude

- Come ready to have fun!
- Come ready to try new things!

R: Respect

- Please follow KYHFOOTY: "Keep your hands, feet, and other objects to yourself."
- Kindness and respect should be shown to all campers, staff and guests at all times.
 - Be gentle with plants and animals at the Garden.
 - Clean up after yourself.
- Please use an indoor voice in the Shafer House and the Garden Kitchen.

E: Empathy

- Follow the Golden Rule: Treat others as you would like to be treated.
 - Lend a helping hand to anyone who needs it.

S: Safety

- Stay with the group at ALL times.
- Please walk, not run, unless we are playing a game
 - Be ready to drink lots of water!
 - Please do not share your food.

Anyone who chooses to not follow the above expectations will:

1. Be given a verbal warning and will discuss behavior with Summer Camp staff. If behavior continues the camper will:
2. Be given a time-out and will discuss behavior with Summer Camp staff. Subsequent timeouts will be increased in length and if more than 1 is given in one day, family will be notified at the end of the day. If more than 3 time outs are given in one day or as deemed appropriate by staff, the camper will:
3. Meet privately with Summer Camp staff and Katlyn, and/or MVMC Executive Director. Parent/Guardian will be called immediately.
4. Depending on severity, if issues continue, child will be dismissed for the remainder of the day or week. Camp tuition will not be refunded.
