

Job Title: Grounds Keeper | MVMC

Purpose: The Moab Valley Multicultural Center (MVMC) is lucky to have a large and beautiful yard which houses four different murals which are open to the public. These murals are a part of our Cultural Education & Outreach Programming. By keeping our yard clean, we ensure a happy, safe, and enjoyable visit for all those who come to check out the murals!

Location: Moab Valley Multicultural Center (MVMC); 156 N 100 W, Moab UT

Key Responsibilities:

- Follow Yard-Cleaning Checklist.
- Clean up trash and yard debris.
- *Knowledge of local, indigenous plants required*: Weed inside garden beds.
- Hang banners, clean bulletin board.

Reports to the Volunteer Coordinator of the MVMC.

The Length of Appointment: Grounds Keepers normally work in rotation. We keep several volunteers on our list so no one is overloaded. Appointment lasts as long as the volunteer wishes.

Time Commitment: Grounds Keeper serves on an as needed basis. This may be for a whole day or for a few hours at a time to meet the needs of the space.

Qualifications: Knowledge of local, indigenous plants and trees. Ability to lift up to 50 lbs. Pleasant manner, patience, independence, problem-solving ability, dependability.

Support: Training for this position will be provided on an as needed basis. Also, the Volunteer Coordinator will be available for questions and assistance.

Age Requirement: Flexible
